



# About Territory Emergency Management Council (TEMC)

The Territory Emergency Management Council (the Council) is established under the Section 36 of the *Emergency Management Act 2013*.

Membership of the Council includes the Commissioner of Police as the Territory Controller (co-chair) the Chief Executive Officer of the Department of the Chief Minister as the Territory Recovery Coordinator (co-chair), the Director of Northern Territory Emergency Service and Chief Executives of government agencies who have a key role in preparing for, responding to and recovering from emergency events in the Northern Territory.

The Council provides leadership and oversight of the Territory's emergency management arrangements.
