	Upon arrival, team finds two live casualties trapped in the vehicle, who are conscious and complaining of neck pain.	
	Learners are expected to treat for spinal injuries and perform extraction using spinal immobilization techniques. Passenger condition to deteriorate & require rapid extraction, driver extraction to be controlled & deliberate.	
	Drill concludes once casualties are safely moved to a simulated ambulance for handover, emphasizing the importance of proper casualty care and transfer procedures.
