Details:	Pairs briefed on a scenario involving a tree lopper who has had a serious mishap with a chainsaw whilst trimming trees.	
	Upon arrival, pair discover a conscious casualty at the base of a tree with a ladder fallen over. The chainsaw is still locked on & running (UE Boom, or actual chainsaw with chain removed). Danger to be identified & dealt with.	
	There is a completely severed hand & lots of blood.	
	Pairs are required to prioritise traumatic bleed by applying a torniquet & performing correct wound management procedures. If bleeding is managed well & in a timely manner, commence secondary survey & treat for shock. If poorly management, CPR required.	
	The pair are also expected to acknowledge & deal with the severed body part in accordance with procedure to preserve it. Body part to be handed over to St John.
