What is personal information?	 how to contact us or the Northern Territory Office of the Information Commissioner (the OIC) about our privacy practices. This notice applies in addition to any previous collection notices and privacy disclaimers you have agreed to as an eligible person to purchase, possess, carry or use OC Spray. Personal information is information by which a person's
	identity is reasonably ascertainable. This can include a person's name, age, gender, residential address, contact details, sensitive information, and health information.
Why is your personal information being collected?	 The Northern Territory Government is collecting, holding, using, verifying, sharing and/or disclosing your personal information provided in this form for the following purposes including: ensuring compliance with legislative requirements to record all sales of OC Spray; ensuring that persons not eligible do not purchase or obtain OC Spray; liaising with you regarding this form or any related matters; meeting reporting obligations within the Northern Territory Government and its agencies, to members of the Northern Territory Parliament, and/or to relevant authorities; for a related secondary purpose; or as otherwise required or authorised by law.
What information do we collect?	 The Northern Territory Government collects personal information about you when you engage with us, including by using and submitting this form at a Declared Dealer. Personal information we collect from you includes but is not limited to: information about your identity, such as your full name, and contact details (including your email address or mobile number); any information contained in identity documents, for example, your driver's licence; your response to any questions, declaration(s) and/or any other details necessary for this form (if required); any feedback you provide.
What would happen if your personal information was not collected?	If you choose not to provide your information, the Northern Territory Government will not be able to process your declaration and you will be unable to purchase OC Spray.





To whom will your personal information be disclosed?	The Northern Territory Government will only use and disclose your personal information for the purposes for which it was collected or otherwise as permitted by the <i>Information Act 2002</i> (NT). Your personal information may be disclosed and shared within the Northern Territory Government and its agencies.
