RETAILERS



Be alert to customers who appear anxious or in a hurry.



If you are unsure or suspicious, ask for additional identification.



Watch out for customers who make a purchase without regard to the price, anxious or rushed.



Report all suspicious activity to police on 131 444.



Be aware of customers who repeatedly return to make additional purchases.



Be aware of customers who present a card from a pocket instead of a purse or wallet.

Keep your cards secure at all times - treat them like cash.



If your phone is able to make electronic payments, ensure that it is locked at all times.



Do not leave your handbag or wallet unattended in a public space.



Contact your financial institution immediately if your card is lost or stolen.



Never lend your card to anyone.



Consider using a RFID blocking wallet. These are particularly useful when travelling overseas.
