

SAFETY TIPS FOR QUAD BIKE RIDERS



Police are targeting vehicles driving on roads and verges without registration.

IT IS ILLEGAL TO DRIVE A QUAD BIKE ON A
PUBLIC ROAD OR PUBLIC PLACE INCLUDING
A PARK, BEACH OR FOOTPATH - UNLESS YOU
HAVE A CONDITIONAL REGISTRATION. Avoid the fine!

You can apply for conditional registration for a quad bike or all-terrain vehicles (ATV) for work related purposes.

You can apply for work related purposes including any of the following:

- roadside litter collection
- herbicide spraying
- ground maintenance
- park management

Driving on wet roads or rough terrain is not regarded as a sufficient reason for conditional registration.
