Northern Territory Firearms Act 1997

This form is a 'Paintball Player Declaration' for the purposes of Section 60K(1)(a), and may also be used for a 'Firearm Club Open Day' to determine that a person may use a firearm under supervision for the provisions of Section 31(1)(fc) of the *Firearms Act 1997*.

Prohibited Persons

(Including persons under the age of 18 years old)

A 'prohibited person' under NT Firearms Act 1997 cannot play paintball nor can they participate at a firearm club open day shoot.

"prohibited person" means a person who:

- (a) is prohibited from applying for any firearm or weapon licence under this Act or a law of a State or another Territory; or
- (b) is not entitled to be granted any licence under this Act, for a reason other than that the person is not a resident, or about to become a resident, of the Territory.

Persons who are prohibited from applying for a licence or are not entitled to be granted a licence under the *Firearms Act* include those who have been:

- subject of a Domestic Violence Order in the last five years (In the Northern Territory the five year period applies from when the Order expires, not when it came into force),
- currently subject to an order to 'keep the peace' issued by a court,
- been found guilty of an offence against the *NT Firearms Act 1997* or the *NT Weapons Control Act 2001* in the last two years (A finding of guilt includes matters where the offence was proved and no conviction recorded),
- been found guilty of an Offence of Violence in the last 5 years (Carefully read the list of Offences of Violence to see if this applies to you. A finding of guilt includes matters where the offence was proved and no conviction recorded),
- been found guilty of a Disqualifying Offence in the last 10 years (Carefully read the list of Disqualifying Offences to see if this applies to you. A finding of guilt includes matters where the offence was proved and no conviction recorded),
- currently subject to a court order that you cannot hold or apply for a firearm licence, or
- currently under a Notice of Suspension, Refusal or Revocation issued under the NT Firearms Act 1997.

If any of the above applies to you, or you think it may apply to you, DO NOT complete the 'Prohibited Person' declaration. You may not be eligible to play paintball nor handle or shoot a firearm under any circumstance.

If you are in doubt as to your circumstances contact the Firearms Policy and Recording Unit (FPRU) at Palmerston to clarify your position.
