### Explanatory Notes

#### New Time Series

- 1 Following the implementation of the NT Police SerPro system on 27 November 2023, the crime statistics from December 2023 onwards have been determined to be not comparable with earlier published NT crime statistics. December 2023 represents a break in the series, and data for December 2023 onwards will be published separately from earlier data.

#### New Offence Classification

- 2 Offences are classified using the new Australian and New Zealand Standard Offence Classification (ANZSOC) 2023, which was developed by the Australian Bureau of Statistics and is currently being implemented by all Australian jurisdictions. The new classification differs from the previous classification, and means that new breakdowns for certain offences are available. The crime statistics published from March 2025 onwards use this classification for all offences, including historical offences. However, users should be careful in comparing statistics published under the new classification with statistics from earlier releases using the old classification, as some offences have been recategorised. A list of key offence recategorisations affecting the NT Crime Statistics is included at "Key changes".

#### Provisional Data

- 3 Statistics for the first four months of publication should be treated as provisional. Numbers of offences in the NT for the latest month may increase by 10-15% over time, while numbers in the three prior months may increase by 5-10%, as investigations and data entry are completed over the next several months. Increases may be larger in the regional data.

- 2 These statistics were prepared by the Criminal Justice Research, Evaluation and Statistics Unit based in the Northern Territory Attorney-General's Department for use by Government agencies, other organisations, researchers and members of the public.
- 3 The information used to prepare these statistics was extracted from SerPro on 1 May 2026. These statistics should not be compared with earlier NT crime statistics for periods prior to December 2023, as the two series are not comparable.
- 4 The offences reported in this document were recorded by the Northern Territory Police in the SerPro system. The data are frequently updated as new information comes to light. Therefore these statistics may differ slightly from those produced for the same time period at an earlier or later date.
- 5 These data represent counts of offences. Offence statistics may not be comparable with those published by other jurisdictions as offence definitions have not been standardised.
- 6 Involvement of domestic violence and/or alcohol in the offence is determined by the NT Police at the time of the offence. In some situations it is not possible to determine whether alcohol is involved in an offence, in which cases alcohol involvement will be recorded as No.
- 7 The Northern Territory has a small population and certain offences show strong seasonal impacts. Therefore, the crime statistics can fluctuate considerably between months, particularly at a regional level. These fluctuations should not, of themselves, be interpreted as changing trends in crime. The crime statistics are also subject to influence from changes in legislation, public behaviour in reporting crime, and Police operations. Care should be used in attributing annual changes to a particular cause.

## Glossary



**Northern Territory Crime Statistics

Acts that threaten, harass, or control	These offences include stalking, threatening behaviour, harassment and private nuisance and coercive control offences. They may be face-to-face, by phone, online, written or by other methods.
Assault	The direct (and immediate/confrontational) infliction of force, injury or violence upon a person or the threat of such force, injury or violence where there is an apprehension that the threat could be enacted, excluding offences of a sexual nature.
Assault of a Prescribed Officer	In the Northern Territory, this includes assaults under section 189A of the Criminal Code Act (assaults on police officers and emergency workers), as well as assaults on the Administrator, a Member of the Legislative Assembly, a Commonwealth or Council official, or a person engaged in the service of court documents. Assaults on workers performing their duties (section 188A of the Criminal Code Act) are included under Serious assault if aggravating factors exist, or Common assault otherwise.
Attempted Murder	<b>Attempted</b> unlawful intentional killing of another person, where death did not actually occur. This includes where there is intent to kill or cause grievous bodily harm with the knowledge that death or grievous harm would occur.
Blackmail or other extortion	The unlawful demand with intent to gain a benefit (eg. money or property) or to cause the detriment of a person/organisation.
Burglary - Dwelling	An actual or attempted unlawful entry at a property that is a residential dwelling with the intent to commit a further offence or a 'break and enter'. Formerly reported as House Break-ins.
Burglary - Dwelling - actual	An <b>actual</b> burglary of a residential dwelling.
Burglary - Dwelling - attempted	An <b>attempted</b> burglary of a residential dwelling.
Burglary - Non-residential	An actual or attempted unlawful entry at a property that is not a residential dwelling with the intent to commit a further offence or "break and enter". These properties include commercial and other non-residential premises. Formerly reported as 'Commercial Break-ins'.
Burglary - Non-residential - actual	An <b>actual</b> burglary of a non-residential or commercial premise.
Burglary - Non-residential - attempted	An <b>attempted</b> burglary of a non-residential or commercial premise.
Common Assault	This is an assault where no serious injury occurs, that does not involve the conditions of a serious assault, and where the victim is not a prescribed officer.
Domestic Violence	Domestic violence is defined by the NT Domestic and Family Violence Act 2007, and includes any of the following conduct committed by a person against someone with whom the person is in a domestic relationship: conduct causing harm (such as sexual or other assault), emotional or psychological abuse, damaging property, intimidation or stalking, coercive control, making a person fear for their safety, economic abuse or attempting or threatening to commit these types of actions. Sexual contact with another person without consent is also defined as domestic violence, though sexual offences are not included in the assaults that are split by domestic violence involvement in Table 2 of this report.
Driving Causing Death	This offence group includes all dangerous driving and hit-and-run driving offences resulting in death. This includes the driving of any type of vehicle, including cars, boats and motorbikes.
Driving Causing Serious Injury	This category includes all dangerous driving and hit-and-run driving offences that result in serious injury. This includes the driving of any type of vehicle, including a cars, boats and motorbikes.
Harm or endanger persons	A wide range of offences that harm or endanger people in accordance with the ANZSOC 04 division. Apart from driving causing serious injury, other dangerous driving offences are not categorised in this division. They are included in the division 13 'Traffic and Vehicle offences'. Traffic and vehicle offences are not reported as part of the crime statistics.
Homicide	The actual or attempted unlawful killing of a person, including murder, attempted murder, manslaughter and driving causing death.
Human trafficking, abduction, deprivation of liberty	This includes ANZSOC subdivisions 041 'Human trafficking or slavery', 042 'Abduction or kidnapping', and 043 'Deprivation of liberty or false imprisonment'.
Manslaughter	The unlawful killing of another person without the intent to kill or deprived of the power of self-control by provocation or with impaired capacity of one's mind.
Motor Vehicle Theft and Related Offences	In the NT, this includes driving, using, or riding in a motor vehicle (including aircraft) without consent. The theft of motor vehicle parts or vehicle contents is reported in the division 07 'Theft'.
Murder	Unlawful <b>intentional</b> killing of another person.
Northern Territory Balance	The Northern Territory Balance is the area of the Northern Territory that lies outside of the six urban centres of Darwin, Palmerston, Alice Springs, Katherine, Tennant Creek and Nhulunbuy.
Offence	An action that contravenes an act of law in force in the Northern Territory or the Commonwealth.
Offences against the Person	These offences includes the ANZSOC divisions 01 'Homicide', 02 'Assault', 03 'Sexual Assault', 04 'Harm or endanger persons', and 05 'Robbery, blackmail and extortion'.
Other Acts that Harm or Endanger Persons	This is the ANZSOC subdivision 049 'Other acts that harm or endanger persons', which includes the offences of intentionally drugging/poisoning a person, the neglect or ill-treatment of a person, failing to report child abuse, and reckless endangerment.

Other Child-related Sexual Offences	These offences include the ANZSOC subdivisions 033 'Child procurement or grooming' and 034 'Child abuse material offences' .
Other Sexual Offences	These offences include the ANZSOC subdivisions 035 'Intimate image offences' and 039 'Other sexual offences'. Public order sexual standards, such as indecent exposure, which had previously not been included in this report, are now included in the subdivision 039 'Other sexual offences'.
Other theft	A broad range of theft offences, excluding 'motor vehicle theft and related offences'.
Property Damage	The unlawful destruction, damage, or defacement of property, including vandalism, graffiti, arson, and interfering with a motor vehicle causing damage.
Property Offences	Includes the ANZSOC divisions of 06 'Burglary', 07 'Theft' and 11 'Property Damage'.
Robbery	Offences involving taking property from a person with the use or threat of immediate force towards that person.
Robbery, blackmail and extortion	Acts intended to gain money, property or other items of value from a person or organisation by using the threat of force or coercive measures.
Serious Assault	Assault offences that involve choking and strangulation or significant injury, or that are associated with aggravating factors such as the use of a weapon.
Sexual Assault	Physical contact or intended contact of a sexual nature where the victim does not give consent, or gives consent as a result of intimidation or deception, or consent is proscribed. Includes rape (actual, intended and attempted) and incest.
Sexual Assault of an Adult	A sexual assault offence against an adult. This category also includes offences where it is unknown from the offence description if the victim is a child or an adult.
Sexual Assault of a Child	A sexual assault offence in which the victim is identified as a child in the offence description.
Sexual Offences	Sexual offences are acts (or intent of acts) of a sexual nature against another person which are non-consensual or where consent cannot be given.
Theft	A broad category of offences involving the unlawful taking or obtaining of money, goods or services without the use of force, or the receipt or handling of stolen money or goods. These offences include motor vehicle theft, stealing, and shoplifting.

Definitions are based on the Australian and New Zealand Standard Offence Classification system of 2023, published by the Australian Bureau of Statistics.

### Key changes to offence classifications affecting the NT Crime Statistics following implementation of the Australian and New Zealand Standard Offence Classification (ANZSOC) 2023.

#### 1. Driving causing death or serious injury

In the old classification, Driving causing death (categorised as Homicide) included only hit-and-run driving resulting in death. Offences involving dangerous or reckless driving resulting in death or serious injury were grouped with other dangerous driving offences in the subdivision of 'dangerous and negligent operation of a vehicle'. This subdivision was excluded from the crime statistics report, as most of these offences do not necessarily have an immediate victim.

In the new classification, all dangerous driving offences resulting in death are included in the subdivision 0132 'Driving causing death', a component of the Homicide division which is included in the crime statistics. Thus it is expected that there will be an increase in the number of offences in this division compared with the old division with the same name, due to the inclusion of these offences.

In the new classification, all driving causing serious injury are now included in subdivision 045 'Driving causing serious injury'. This is part of the new division 04 'Harm or Endanger Persons', which is included in the crime statistics.

Note: There is one offence in the NT which is described as 'Driving motor vehicle causing death or serious harm'. Upon investigation, it was found that approximately one-third of these offences resulted in the death of a victim. Therefore, this offence has been classified in the '01 Homicide' division.

#### 2. Assault

In the old classification, the offence of making a threat to kill someone was categorised as Assault. In the new classification, this offence is now categorised as 0442 Threatening behaviour. The count of assault offences has decreased slightly as a result, and the offences are now reported under 044 Acts that threaten, harass or control.

#### 3. Other sexual offences

This category includes offences previously categorised as offences against public order sexual standards, which were considered public order offences and not reported in the crime statistics. Included are offences such as indecent behaviour in a public place and indecent exposure. In the new classification, these offences are now classed under other sexual offences.

#### 4. Harm or endanger persons

This category includes offences previously categorised as Abduction, Harassment and Other Offences, or as Other Dangerous or Negligent Acts Endangering Persons. The new category now includes threats to kill (previously Assault, now Threatening behaviour), and Driving causing serious injury (previously not reported with the crime statistics as it was classed with general dangerous driving offences).

### 5. Property offences

In general, property offences reported in the NT Crime Statistics show little or no change as a result of the recategorisation. An exception is property damage offences, where a small number of offences involving interference with a vehicle, boat, or fishing operations have been reclassified as disruptive conduct under public safety offences, which are not reported as part of the crime statistics.

### Overall impact

As a result of the recategorisation of offences, the 2024 year has 0.6% more Offences against the person and 0.2% fewer Offences against property reported in the NT Crime Statistics under the new classification system than under the old system. The offences no longer reported have not been deleted: they have been recategorised under the new national offence classification scheme and are no longer included in the categories covered by the NT Crime Statistics. Similarly, the offences now reported have not been created: as a result of the recategorisation they are now included in categories reported in the NT Crime Statistics.
